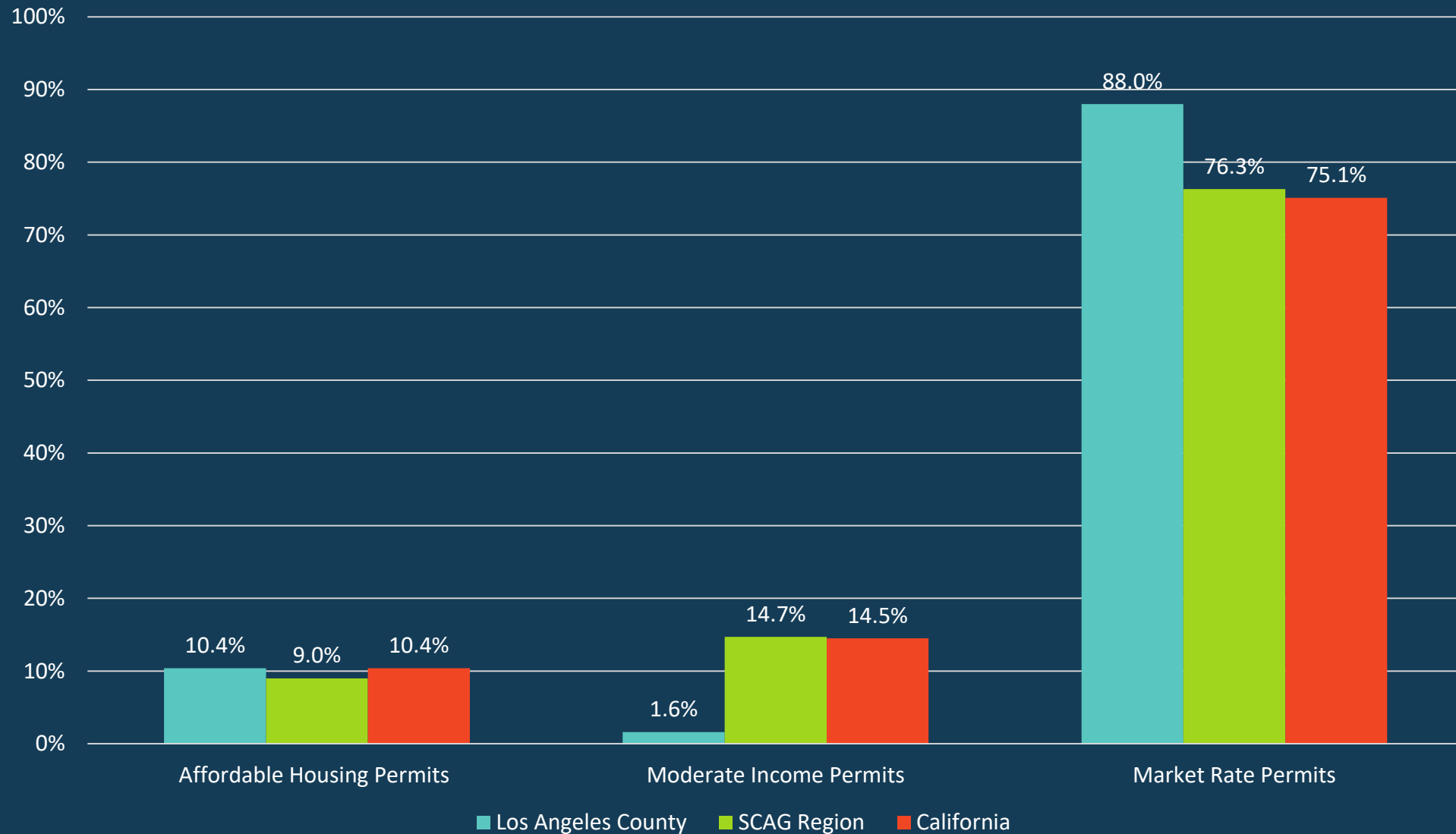

Barriers to Regional Housing Planning

- Local control
 - Housing permitting is done at the local level
- Lack of incentives to care about neighboring cities
- Lack of funding
- NIMBY

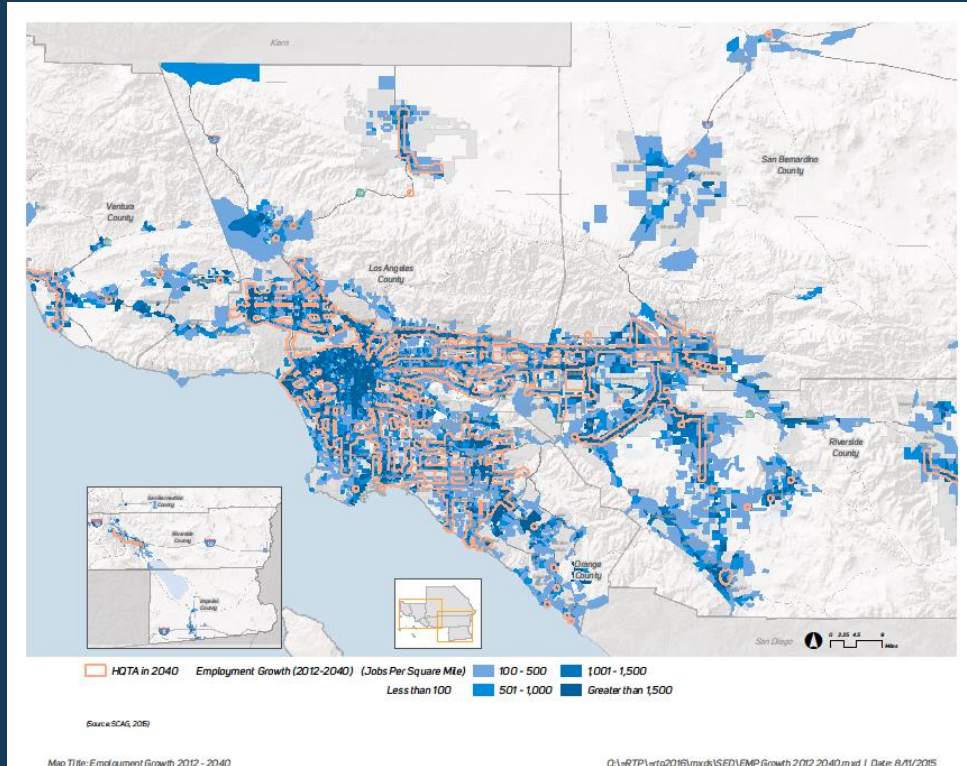


Why Regional Housing Planning?

- Housing issues go beyond city boundaries
 - Economic development
 - Traffic impacts
 - Environmental impacts
- Better coordination with regional transportation planning
 - Targeting areas with economic growth potential
 - Areas with high scores of walkability
 - Areas with high transit use

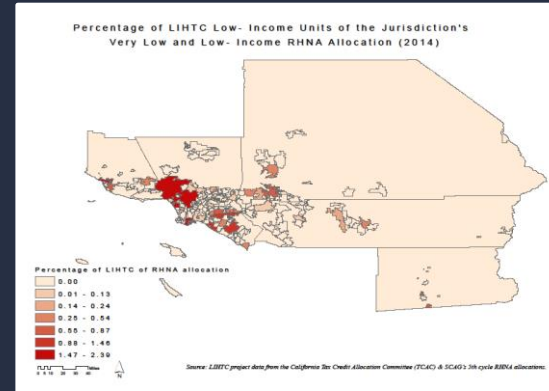
Thinking Regionally

- You can't talk about traffic without talking about housing
- You can't talk about jobs without talking about housing
 - Housing is where jobs sleep at night
- The housing crisis is a collective problem... and requires a collective solution



SCAG's Role in Regional Housing Planning

- Regional Housing Need Assessment (RHNA)
- Connect SoCal: Regional Transportation Plan/Sustainable Communities Strategy (RTP/SCS)
- Toolbox and Best Practices
- Technical Support for Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities Program (aka “Cap and Trade”)
- Facilitation of local stakeholder meetings and workshops
