

# **ULI Local Council/Committee Compact**

#### MISSION

The council provides member value and delivers the global mission of the organization while fulfilling the ULI Philadelphia Strategic Plan goals. Each council is expected to create a mission that serves the greater mission of the organization.

### **ROLE OF THE COUNCIL**

The Council takes responsibility for developing at least one local program for the District Council open to all members or the public.

### PREREQUISITES TO JOINING A COUNCIL

- ULI Member
- Attended at least one ULI event in the past year

## **EXPECTATIONS OF MEMBERS**

- Each member is responsible for organizing at least one component of a meeting per year (speaker, conference room, etc.) or developing a program of work
- Members are expected to miss no more than 3 meetings in a fiscal year
- Members encouraged to attend at least 2 local events per year
- Council sizes are limited to optimize council experience
- Recruitment of members

## **EXPECTATIONS OF CO-CHAIRS**

- Maintain your ULI membership in good standing and abide by the ULI Code of Ethics.
- Use the ULI culture, brand and priorities in your work, to engage your teams in the core values of the Institute.
- Support membership by helping to engage existing members, recruit new members, and serve as a mentor when asked.
- Where possible, engage in national and global ULI activities such as serving as a Full Member, joining a Product Council, and participating in the Fall and/or Spring meetings.
- Providing leadership in content and programming as well as empowering council members to take on tasks.
- Convening (or delegating among council members) meetings, meeting notes and assignments.
- Attend 75 percent or more of group's meetings.
- Fulfill specific Council responsibilities regarding programming.
- Provide value to council members by providing leadership opportunities and relevant content.
- Each individual Council will draft news "Charters" this year.
- Serve in leadership capacity for at least one and up to two years.
