The District Council is thrilled to launch the sixth year of the ULI Mentor Program in September 2019. As we embark on this journey, we are excited to see how the program continues to grow.

With Nashville's tremendous growth and the influx of talented, new members to our District Council, this is the ideal time to continue building the foundation of a program that amplifies ULI's ability to help build a strong 'next generation' of professionals.

We are seeking ULI members to serve as Mentors.

Structure

The Nashville Mentor program was developed using examples of other successful Mentor programs including ULI San Francisco, ULI New York, ULI Phoenix, and ULI Orange County.

The one-on-one Mentor/Mentee experience is structured as follows:

- Term: ten months from September 2019 through June 2020.
- Interactions: a Mentor and Mentee are expected touch base only once per month during the ten month program. This may take place during a ULI Nashville event, a scheduled meeting or an informal discussion over lunch. Another opportunity that will 'count' as one of the monthly get-togethers will be at one of the three ULI Mentor Program meetings scheduled to bring together all Mentors and Mentees. - The relationship can be as formal or informal as you and your Mentee choose for it to be.
