The Reisterstown Plaza Metro Station located at 6300 Wabash Avenue is a gem of a development site having approximately 26 acres of unimproved land and surfaced parking lots located at a highly visible intersection. Mature trees and adjacent stream are nestled between surface parking and adjacent 538,000 SF Social Security Administration Building. The Metro Station has approximately 34,000 monthly boardings and is approximately 15 minutes from downtown Baltimore City. The site is zoned TOD-3 and TOD-4.
