Actual Numbers

- 2,965 More store openings than closings in 2019 (11,393 openings to 8,428 closings)
- 1,065 chains announced store openings in 2019, only 206 announced closings
- Only 19% of all retail sales happen online, only 10.2% by online only outlets. The other 8.8% is by retailers with brick and mortar presence
- Experiential Retail and Restaurants are driving growth.

Nashville

- Retail Vacancy holding at 2.9% (National average is 6.5%)
- Net absorption is up, but deliveries and under construction numbers are down slightly
- Notable retailer openings:
 - Publix (North Gulch)
 - Crate & Barrel (Green Hills Mall)
 - Assembly Food Hall (Fifth & Broad)
 - Whole Foods (1200 Broadway)
 - Rumored Tech Retailer (Fifth & Broad)









Nashville Retail 2020

- More of the same
 - Numbers will look a lot like 2019
 - Significant continued growth downtown taking advantage of tourist spending and added jobs
 - Less suburban ground up development
 - More redevelopment of older shopping centers
 - More retail in mixed use developments





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
