



**DINA ROLLMAN**

Dina leads Green Thumb's government affairs activities at the state, local, and federal level. Dina began her involvement with Green Thumb and the cannabis industry in 2014 by helping Green Thumb apply for its Illinois licenses, and thereafter served as first external and then in-house regulatory compliance and litigation counsel before transitioning to lead its government affairs department in 2019.

Dina is an experienced attorney who, prior to joining Green Thumb and specializing in cannabis law, was a partner at a commercial litigation law firm, representing plaintiffs and defendants in complex business disputes throughout the country.

Dina's passion for and leadership in the cannabis industry runs deep. Since 2014 she has been the co-founder and President of Illinois Women in Cannabis, a not-for-profit group that promotes women's role in Illinois' regulated cannabis industry. In 2017 she co-created and co-taught Illinois' first Cannabis Law & Policy course as an adjunct professor at Chicago-Kent College of Law, and over the years she has lectured widely on cannabis topics at national trade conferences and national legal conferences. In 2019 Dina created Green Thumb's social equity License Education Application Program (LEAP), which helped applicants navigate the adult use cannabis business application process in Illinois and which will soon incubate social equity licensees.

The Chicago Sun-Times named Dina to its list of the top 10 most influential people in the Illinois cannabis industry in 2018 and she was included in the Chicago Business Journal's Chicago Women of Influence list in 2019. In 2021 Dina was named a Midwest Trailblazer by The American Lawyer, which recognizes legal professionals who have made a significant impact in their industry.

She earned a Bachelor of Arts from Oberlin College and a law degree from Northwestern University School of Law.
