- Work Experience:** Minimum of 7 years experience in the real estate industry or related field, including development, architecture, planning, government, transportation, engineering, finance, sustainability, and non-profits.
- Commitment:** The Leadership Institute requires a significant time commitment. It is an eight-month program with seven full-day seminars and a group project. If accepted to this prestigious and competitive program, you are pledging in good faith to be fully-engaged and involved. Attendance to BOTH the FIRST program day and the LAST program day (Graduation) is mandatory, and one excused absence during the other months is permitted.
