Summary of the Event

On a cool, early-autumn afternoon, more than a hundred people gathered in a welcoming room off King St. to explore the intersection of technology and real estate. When Richard Joy, executive director of ULI Toronto, hopped up on the low stage to kick off the formal presentation, he noted the context in which the 2022 ULI Toronto × PropTech Collective Connections event was taking place: The real estate and technology "ecosystems haven't always had the strongest interaction," he said.

"Today's event is a science experiment to see if this intersection has gained some energy we can harness going forward."

Harnessing that energy is Proptech Collective's reason for being, as co-founder Courtney Cooper outlined in her welcome speech. The occasion itself—and, as she noted, the bustle in the room—suggested a positive outlook for its mission to bring realestate professionals, technologies, entrepreneurs, and city builders together. Keynote speaker Duncan Stewart

underscored that optimism with a snappy half-hour survey of trends in technology. From 3-D printing and self-driving cars to Wi-Fi 6, the chip shortage, and the metaverse, he offered quick summaries of the current state of affairs and pointed toward the horizon—for both consumers and enterprise customers. While a quick audience poll revealed some felt a little swamped by the deluge, for most it was an exciting panorama.

Amy Erixon, of Avison Young, and Carlos Gutierrez, of IBI Group, had been tapped to ask follow-up questions, and both jumped to an important topic: the value of data and the importance of securing it. What opportunities and liabilities exist as real-estate firms collect more data. both pre- and post-construction, and as more aspects of the construction and management process become digitized? Stewart suggested that with data comes liability, but that the amounts gathered even by players as large as Brookfield and Cadillac Fairview pale in comparison to that held in trust by the larger tech platforms. For now, he suggested, it's sufficient to act responsibly and keep an eye on the regulatory conversation around artificial intelligence and other real-estate uses of big data.



A series of audience questions led naturally to the heart of the event: conversations among real-estate and development professionals and the leaders of nearly two-dozen PropTech startups. At intimate tables, founders spent time introducing their peers to innovative tools that help with electric-vehicle charging, soil measurement, rent-to-own financing, indoor pathogen risk management, robotics automation, and much else besides. It was quickly apparent that the groupings had been thoughtfully constructed, as each group naturally expanded its conversation to broader questions about real estate, development, and urban life.



How do we design cities to change habits around car use? How can we streamline regulatory frameworks in order to better achieve our goals? How does one manage to double fundraise, both for a company and for the capital needed to lend to customers? If buying technology products alone doesn't solve problems, how do we achieve buy-in to make the best use of its advantages? What price premium are developers and construction firms willing to pay for "green" solutions? And what is needed to lower those premiums?

Such questions were unanswerable in an hourlong session. But what they reveal is that the evolution of the real-estate industry, and the role of PropTech companies in that development, depends on people as well as tools.

At one end of the room, an interactive station allowed attendees to mark themselves along a bunch of spectrums: from "flying solo" to "teamwork"; from "innovative" to "tried and true"; from "336 notifications" to "do not disturb." Using colorful stickers, people had





placed themselves at all points along these lines, but where they clumped together suggested an overall openness to new technologies and ideas. This, along with how the conversations carried over into happy hour and often ended with promises to stay in touch, suggested that this event—this "science experiment"—had been a rousing success. It was surely, as Joy often likes to note, the start of many more conversations to come.


