# Team 4: Processes – Key Take Aways


- Processes in city building and urban design come in topdown and bottom-up approaches
- Top-down approaches echo urban planning rationales of Le Corbusier, Bottom-Up similarly echoes the work of Jane Jacobs.
- Finding the shared ground between the two develops a Hybrid process.
- This allows bottom-up input with top-down procedures to marry the two ideals.
- We believe Community Joy can be brought out in a thorough implementation of a Hybrid approach.
- Real world example: 20<sup>th</sup> century Post-War Tokyo.






