If you are ready to strengthen your leadership impact and advance your career, then the WLI Executive Academy is for you.

Join a dynamic group of mid-career women who are ready to expand their networks, build their capabilities and shape the future of city building.

The WLI Executive Academy is an MBA-style, multi-module professional development program designed for mid-level city building professionals with a minimum of 10 years of experience.

Following a series of professional-led workshops, seminars and practical learning opportunities, participants will graduate from the program with:

- A stronger understanding of leadership fundamentals
- Greater confidence in networking and relationship building
- An enhanced ability to collaborate effectively within teams
- Practical strategies for navigating career growth

- Increased awareness of emerging technologies and how they are influencing the industry

The WLI Executive Academy will take place over one year, beginning in November, with one learning module hosted each quarter. Spacing the modules throughout the year will allow participants to apply their learning in real time within the workplace, at networking events, during conferences and in other professional settings. Insights and lessons learned from the real-world application of the training will inform and strengthen the learning outcomes of the program.

The goal is not only to learn, but to put that learning into practice, reflect on what works and build greater confidence and capability over time.

The journey into leadership is not linear nor the same for everyone. The WLI Executive Academy will equip participants with the skills, relationships and practical tools to navigate their careers with greater confidence, strengthen their leadership impact and shape the future of city building.

Due to the highly interactive program design, participation is limited to a cohort of 20 to 30 women. Selection will be based on the completed application and criteria designed

to bring together a diverse mix of perspectives, experiences and areas of expertise that will contribute to a meaningful and dynamic learning exchange.

You must be a ULI member in order to participate in the Executive Academy. Non-members are welcome to apply, but they must become a ULI member prior to the commencement of the first module.

We strongly encourage every interested candidate who meets the minimum experience requirement to apply, regardless of their current employment status, career path or lived experience. We recognize that talent and leadership potential take many forms, and there is no single path to being a strong candidate for the Academy.

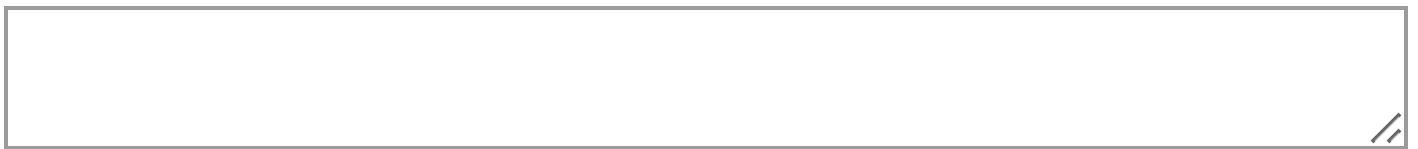
