Criteria

- <u>Career Accomplishments:</u> Longstanding history and demonstrated record of leadership and career accomplishments with quantifiable results of the positive impact on The Metropolitan Washington Region and its many vibrant communities.
- <u>Experience:</u> 25+ years of experience.
- Location: Professional work must occur within The Metropolitan Washington Region.
- Industry: Any sector of real estate and/or land use.
- <u>ULI Membership:</u> A current ULI Washington membership or partnership is preferred, but not required.
- <u>Nomination:</u> Third-party nomination only.

- Industry: Private sector, public sector, or nonprofit organization.

- <u>Nomination:</u> Eligible for self or third-party nomination.
