


The Relay Use Case

• Create first-mile/last-mile connection


Engage a diverse set of Fairfax County residents





Details on Relay

- Autonomous vehicle with safety steward onboard
- Zero-emissions Easymile EZ10 Gen3 vehicle
- Route operates between Dunn Loring Metro and Mosaic District
- Runs Monday Thursday 10 am to 2 pm







Preparations for Project Launch

- Development of a site assessment report
- Identification of storage site and mechanic shop
- Installation of signage along route
- Configuration of transit signal prioritization (TSP)
- Extensive training and evaluation of safety steward – always onboard to ensure a safe operation
- Training sessions with local fire and police departments to respond to incidents involving Relay

 - Increased cleaning
 - Mask mandate
 - Limit on passenger capacity
