Entrance to the bank is on Trade Street, and by the front door, there is a speaker on the wall. Please announce yourself using the speaker and the security officer will open the door for you. Please have a picture ID with you. Upon entering the building, you will be asked to place all handheld items on a conveyor to be x-rayed and to walk through a metal detector. Security will notify a staff person to take you to the meeting room.

These procedures are routine for all visitors and usually take about 5 - 7 minutes, so you may want to arrive a few minutes early. NOTE: The Bank's current safety protocols require that all guests and visitors to be fully vaccinated and reserves the right to require proof of vaccination prior to entry.
