

# PROJECT SUBMITTAL INSTRUCTIONS, CHECKLIST, AND COPY OF ONLINE APPLICATION

\*\*\*This application is for preparation and review purposes only. All project applications must be submitted via the online form.

Thank you for your interest in submitting a project for ULI Colorado's 2021 Impact Awards.

### **General Submittal Instructions:**

- 1. Applicants must provide all requested information in the online project application and submittal checklist for each award. Incomplete submittals will be rejected.
- You may submit your project in ONE category, but you may also submit as many projects as
  you would like. You can submit more than one project in the same category if you wish. Each
  project requires a separate submittal to include the application, supporting materials, and
  submittal fee.
- 3. All Project Applications should be submitted and are **only accepted through the online form**. Please use the PDF of the Project Application reference document to organize your answers <u>before</u> completing the online form. You will not be able to save your application online and come back to edit it.
- 4. Project images and any additional supporting documentation should be submitted in one of two possible ways:

**Option One:** organize the contents of the "submittal requirement checklist" into a virtual project folder and share this via cloud-based sharing platform to <a href="Colorado@uli.org">Colorado@uli.org</a>. Please also send an email to <a href="Colorado@uli.org">colorado@uli.org</a> to ensure the contents were received.

**Option Two:** organize the contents of the "submittal requirement checklist" onto a USB and mail this to the ULI Colorado local office address:

Please include a cover letter noting your company and project as well as the the contents of the USB. Due to COVID related building requirements and remote work hours no in person or drop off deliveries will be possible. All submittal packets being mailed to us must be received on or before the application deadline date.

5. **Award Submittal Fees:** There are two possible fee structures. If the entity submitting the application is a <u>public organization</u>, the fee is: \$400. If the entity submitting the application is a private company, the fee is: \$600.

Please note, you may submit your project in ONE category. You may submit as many projects as you would like. You can submit multiple projects in the same category if you wish. But you may not submit the same project in more than one category.

Important: each project requires a separate application, submittal package, and submittal fee.

All payments must be made via Credit Card at this link. If you require an invoice or if you are paying for more than one submittal, please send an email requesting an invoice copy to Colorado @uli.org. Please note: All payments are required to have processed before the application deadline of May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021. You do not need to wait until your project(s) have been submitted to make the submittal fee.

- 3. Put together your project submittal packet in support of the online application and deliver to ULI Colorado either through a cloud based sharing platform of your choice or by mail via the above instructions.

#### This packet should include the following items:

- A) A locator map showing the project's location relative to its metropolitan area.
- B) A project site plan.
- C) Additional descriptive images should be provided to reinforce your project submittal and convey an award worthy effort. Recommend 5- 10 high quality images or renderings.
- D) A brief one-line description for each image should be typed on a separate "project images" sheet. Please number each image and properly credit the photographer. You may combine image descriptions with a color "contact sheet" showing thumbnails of included images.
- E) A completed authorization form signed by the project's developer. Please see below for a copy of this form. You may also find this on the Impact Awards project submittal page.
- F) (Optional) Any further supporting financial information beyond that which is included in the application. If you would like to include any further financial information that conveys an award worthy project or you need to explain further any answers to financial questions on the application, please do so here. This piece is completely optional.

Keep in mind that project images are instrumental in helping the jury understand your entry. In addition, images from each category finalist are used to make a video to be presented at the awards ceremony. Images should be 1024x768 pixels or greater and formats accepted are JPG, GIF, PNG, and TIFF.
