	The area of study is located in a DRCOG community
	Applicant has a letter of support
	Applicant has attached a non-binding pledge of \$12,500
Applicant must meet the above criteria before submitting an application.	
2. Application	
	Applicant has submitted a project narrative with a defined study area and proposed scope of work
	Applicant has crafted a problem statement
	Applicant has submitted questions for the panel to address
3. Scoring	
	Application has clear identification and definition of the obstacles and challenges to creating successful development/redevelopment
	Applicant's project has potential to benefit stakeholders and the broader community
	Applicant's project narrative translates a clear, concise and articulate scope for the TAP
	The application demonstrates the exemplary potential of the project as a successful development that embodies ULI's best practices [link]
	The applicant's project has potential to win broad support, investment and market success
