- Produced four advisory services projects, conducting two Technical Assistance Panels on responsible growth in Exton, PA and investment in life sciences manufacturing in the Lower Schuylkill District of Philadelphia; and two national Advisory Services Panels, targeted at helping the City preserve Philadelphia's naturally occurring affordable housing stock and the Delaware River Waterfront Corporation strategize resilient pier development strategies along the waterfront.
- Provided a 4-part career and professional development training through a newly developed Mentorship Program.
- Leveraged our global networks to provide real-time information through 30+ live and on-demand **webinars**, including <u>partner events</u> with neighboring District Councils to convene on regional conversations.
- Continued to convene and engage hundreds of members around relevant real estate and land use topics.

This work just scratches the surface. As we enter a new fiscal year, we will continue to support and drive policy work through partnerships in the Future of Work, Life Sciences, Housing Affordability and Sustainability.
