- Selected as one of five District Councils for the inaugural **ULI Homeless to Housed Initiative** which led to two technical assistance panels with local service providers seeking to leverage their real estate assets for supportive housing.
- Brought back for a second year the WMBE Fair and Reception presented by the Women's Leadership Initiative, with more than 120+ attendees and more than 30 vendors.

As we enter a new fiscal year, we are excited to continue to deliver on our strategic plan that will chart the path for ULI Philadelphia through 2025 and focus on our priorities outlined above.
