In 2024, ULI SA was selected to participate in the 2nd Cohort of ULI's Homeless to Housed Initiative and will study transitional housing for At-Risk Youth. ULI SA will also continue its work with ULI's Terwilliger Center for Housing on an Attainable Housing for All grant which is managing a virtual visual preference survey on housing typologies. Other recent grants included the Cohort for Parks Equity which funded a TAP about the future of Rosedale Park. The Curtis grant studied opportunities for Mobility Hubs in SA.
