ULI San Antonio also worked with ULI's Terwilliger Center for Housing on an Attainable Housing for All grant which is managing a virtual visual preference survey on housing typologies. Other recent grants included the Cohort for Parks Equity which funded a TAP about the future of Rosedale Park. The Curtis grant studied opportunities for Mobility Hubs in SA.
