Real Estate Diversity Initiative (REDI)

REDI is a comprehensive, 15-session curriculum designed to advance the real estate development careers of professionals of color and women.

Thirty participants step into the role of a real estate developer, gaining direct knowledge and experience working in teams to produce a development plan, pro forma, and marketing plan for a project in St. Louis.

Participants are taught by a volunteer faculty of experienced, multi-disciplinary, top-tier practicing real estate professionals serving as instructors, mentors, and facilitators who share market-based knowledge and the wisdom from the field.

The program concludes with REDI teams presenting their development proposals to a panel of real estate professionals who engage the participants and provide constructive feedback.
