The two-year, Chamberlin YLG Public & Nonprofit Sector Fellowship Program provides the highest level of exposure to the ULI experience for exemplary young professionals working in the nonprofit and/or public sectors. Through this fellowship program, professionals are provided with the opportunity to become integrated into ULI's vast network of land use and real estate professionals by participating in local and national events and a national product council at a formative point in their careers.

Fellowship Details

This two-year YLG Public & Nonprofit Sector Fellowship includes the following benefits:

- Two-years of ULI Full Membership.
- Registration to attend ULI Spring and Fall Meetings for two years, including travel and lodging.
- Registration to one additional domestic ULI conference annually for two years, including travel and lodging.
- Admission to a national Product Council, its meetings, and its functions for two years.
- Access to a mentor who will advise and guide them through ULI and the industry.

Selection Criteria

Fellows must have:

- Demonstrated a passion for real estate as a career objective through their profession, extracurricular activities and/or past pursuit of real estate course work.
- A willingness and desire to commit to active participation in ULI meetings; and
- Employment in the public or non-profit sectors related to land use in the San Francisco Bay Area.

Application Requirements

1. Current **resume**
2. Completed **Application Form** (see page 3).
3. One signed **letter of support** (see page 4) from an employer.
4. Two of the following **essay questions** answered. Essays should be no more than one page in length.
 - a. Why is a ULI Fellowship important to you?
 - b. In your opinion, what is the greatest challenge that real estate and development professionals of your generation will face in the future? What are your ideas for overcoming those issues?
 - c. Professionally, where do you see yourself in 5 years?

Applications for the ULI Graduate Student Fellowship must be received by 11:59 pm (PDT) on Monday, May 20, 2024. Applications can be emailed to sanfrancisco@uli.org.

The Selection Committee will make its decision based on the applications submitted. The fellowship process will not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, color, national origin, sex, age or disability.
