Our sponsors make that work possible.

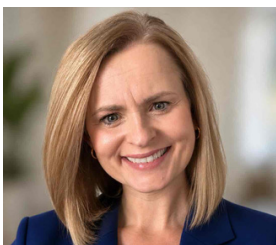
