Started in the CRE industry in 2009 during the Great Recession in Arizona, one of the worst. Working for a boutique developer, Alexis started off leasing their shopping centers in Latino markets. Soon, she worked her way into working and representing tenants, learned underwriting and site selection to get into acquisitions, and later founded her own development company.

On the development side, Alexis has developed projects for national credit tenants and is intent on bringing value to communities by delivering quality, elevated, and 'cool' projects.

On the brokerage side, Alexis works with several national brands including Yum Brand's Habit Burger, T-Mobile, Melrose, and Family Sports Concepts in addition to working with regional and local tenants like Pressed Roots, Earth Bar, Beauty and Propaganda; as well as international brands like Charly, Caffenio, and Empresa.

In 2010 Alexis was part of the team that created the ICSC Hispanic Initiative and was the Arizona chair. She participated in organizing the first and subsequent national conferences as well as hosted and organized the Arizona conferences. Alexis has also participated and presented in ReCon Latin America.

In 2019, she won CenterBuild's Leaders Under 40 Award and is now on their planning committee, and was also selected to be one of ICSC's NextGen Leaders.

Alexis has a vision not just for her company and her developments but for commercial real estate as a whole. As a Latina, Alexis has to navigate through a challenging environment and industry that is not always so welcoming to women and minorities. Alexis not only believes in, but has the conviction in giving opportunity to people and under-served communities. It is well known in the CRE industry that women and minorities hold a fraction of positions and even more so, executive level positions and women still get paid less. Alexis is committed to improving these realities.

Alexis is relentless, creative, empathetic, and has a strong suit in networking and relationship building. Outside of her career life, Alexis is a young professional board member of Covenant House, a non-profit shelter for homeless youth and Women's Political Committee, a Super PAC that supports women in office.
