

André F. Bueno is the Chief Investment Officer at Better Angels, a Los Angeles-based social impact fund targeting over \$1 billion in investments across LA County. With a focus on affordable housing, André co-chairs the ULI Homelessness Initiative Council and has evaluated over 1,200 transactions while leading key strategic discussions with stakeholders such as LAHSA and the Mayor's Office.

Previously, André advised the Mayors of Los Angeles and Long Beach on housing solutions and led a \$2 billion acquisition strategy for a nonprofit developer. At the Housing Authority of the City of LA, he managed a \$1.66 billion portfolio and developed a \$166 million interim housing strategy for 1,500 people.

His experience spans over a decade of real estate development, recycling capital into 29 projects and redeveloping 301 apartments at Bueno Group. He began his career at Morgan Stanley and Goldman Sachs and holds a Bachelor's degree from Loyola Marymount University, with fellowships from Stanford, UPenn, and USC.
