Executive Leadership Coach Valia Glytsis

<u>On June 17th, 2020</u>, WLI New York held a Virtual Workshop with Executive Leadership Coach Valia Glytsis entitled *Change: Shifting from Surviving to Grounding and Finding Your Footing in a Time of Chaotic Change*. The event allowed WLI women to take time out to slow down and be mindful of their approach to managing stress during these challenging times. Attendees shared their current personal mindsets and approaches to navigating uncertainty. Valia shared tips and strategies for managing energy and prioritizing meaningful self-care.

Virtual Career Development Seminar

<u>On June 19th, 2020</u>, our WLI New York University Outreach Committee put on a Virtual Career Development Seminar that welcomed over 70 attendees spanning both university students and ULI members alike.
