1. Experienced Professional: Those poised to assume leadership positions in the North Florida Region or their profession in the near-term.
2. Work Experience: Minimum of 5 years' experience in the real estate industry or related field, including, but not limited to, development, architecture, planning, law, construction, government, transportation, engineering, finance, sustainability, and non-profits.
3. Commitment: The Center for Leadership requires a significant time commitment. It is an eight-month program with eight full-day seminars and a group project. If accepted to this prestigious, competitive program, you are pledging in good faith to be fully-engaged and involved.
