TRENDS IN REAL ESTATE

ULI North Florida hosts the Trends in Real Estate program annually in Jacksonville and Tallahassee. This signature event brings together industry experts and reports on national and local trends that are occurring in the real estate industry.

> JACKSONVILLE

In 2024, the half-day conference had over 200 attendees. Presented by Live Oak Contracting and Regency Centers, conference sessions included Major Projects Redefining Downtown, Insurance, Challenges in Construction, Redemptive Development, and the PwC Outlook for 2024.

> TALLAHASSEE

The 2024 event featured the PwC Outlook for 2024 and industry updates with local leaders including Autumn Calder, Barry Wilcox, Christian Griffith, Erin Tilton, Megan Doherty, and Steve Auger. With over 150 attendees, this is the largest attended event in the region hosted by the Capital Region Board.

ANNUAL CHARITY GOLF TOURNAMENT

Over 100 people participated in the 4th Annual Golf Tournament held in the spring at Queen's Harbor and presented by Nuveen Green Capital. Proceeds from this popular fundraiser go towards supporting local programming and initiatives for members.

FLORIDA SUMMIT

The Florida Summit brought together over 800 land use and real estate leaders from around the state. Attendees enjoyed the opportunity to connect with other Florida District Councils including Tampa Bay, Central, Southwest, and Southeast Florida. The event featured engaging panel discussions, exclusive tours, and energetic networking, making it an unforgettable experience for all participants.

SOUTHEASTERN COASTAL DEVELOPMENT FORUM

The Southeastern Coastal Development Forum is a biennial, two-day event hosted by ULI Atlanta, ULI North Florida, and ULI South Carolina. It provides private and public sector professionals with valuable resources and insights to address coastal development challenges. The inaugural event was held in Savannah, and the next forum will take place in Jacksonville in 2026.

AWARDS FOR EXCELLENCE

The Awards for Excellence honor exceptional development projects that embody ULI North Florida's mission and values. The development teams receiving this prestigious award demonstrate innovation, responsible land use, and a positive community impact. The event, presented by Kilinski | Van Wyk, welcomed nearly 300 attendees. ULI Executive Vice President Jill Lucken and ZOM Living CEO Greg West served as emcees, helping to recognize seven projects across categories including New Development, Urban Development, Reuse/Repurpose, Public Sector, Organization of Influence, and the Judge's Choice Award.

Additionally, the ULI North Florida District Council presented the 2024 Visionary Leader Award to Aundra Wallace, president of JAXUSA Partnership, the regional economic development arm of the JAX Chamber. The award recognizes an individual who has made an outstanding contribution within the real estate industry and the community as a whole.
