Started by the San Francisco YLG chapter in 2005, the Learning from the Best (LFTB) program is now being implemented by YLG chapters across the country. During the program, Young Leaders and Next-Gen real estate industry professionals will spend quality time with local leaders allowing for a broad mix of insights.

This year, we are excited to bring this event back to Pittsburgh for a third time, featuring an all-star lineup of Pittsburgh's top real estate professionals. 





Event Format

- 4. Happy hour drinks 🛍




Timeline











Questions

1. Who can participate?

The program is open to anyone, yet our main focus group for mentees will be the pool of active ULI YLG members.

2. Mentor / Mentee ratio?

Ideally, each mentor is paired with 2-3 mentees.

3. Is there a cost to enter the program?
