

COMMONWEALTH HOUSING EXCHANGE

ULI Philadelphia and ULI Pittsburgh are partnering on an exchange to develop a cohort of interdisciplinary members from across Pennsylvania addressing the Commonwealth's shortage of attainable housing. The Exchange will be focused on identifying solutions to increase housing choices and removing barriers in the preservation and creation of new housing locally, regionally, and statewide.

The Philadelphia and Pittsburgh regions are major job centers with immediate access to schools, public transit, healthcare, and other essential services in an otherwise largely rural state. It is critical to provide an adequate housing supply in these regions. This presents a unique opportunity to deepen ULI's local body of work around our mission priority of attainable housing, further cementing ULI members as experts on these topics, and institutionalizing this work within ULI Philadelphia and ULI Pittsburgh.

Through the Exchange, Philadelphia and Pittsburgh will work collaboratively to recruit up to 15 participants from each District Council (30 total participants) which will include policymakers, community leaders, developers, funders, designers, and other real estate professionals in the housing industry to advance solutions to these issues that promote equity, opportunity, and prosperity for all.

The participants will spend two days in each city attending a series of keynote speaking sessions, tours, and workshops on predefined topics. Each workshop will result in documented recommendations and calls to action that will be summarized in a single white paper. The report can be leveraged by partners and other housing groups to advance the recommendations and calls to action.

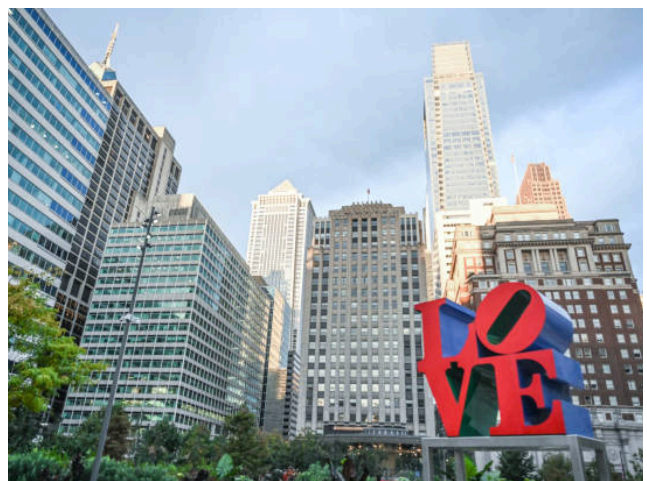
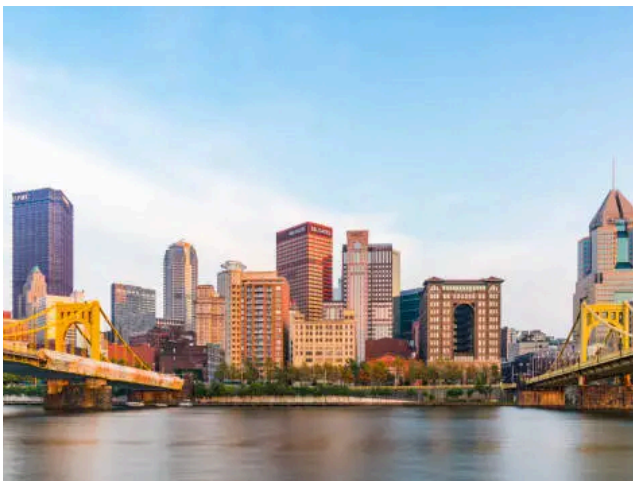
