



# Letter from the District Council Chair

Dear Friends,

Reflecting on the last several months, it appears clear to me that if 2020 was the year we were tested, this year we have proven just how resilient a community we can be. It is so rewarding to see how much progress ULI Austin has made – not only in rebounding from the impacts of a global pandemic and economic crisis – but in making sweeping advancements as an organization.

This year our membership continued to grow despite the pandemic, reaching over 1050 members. We have begun to return in-person to our remarkable programs and we have achieved new milestones in participation. We have been awarded a grant to study more progressive energy considerations, which will help address climate change. And each of our Committees and Councils are fostering rich dialogue and tackling some of the biggest issues in our community: affordability, mobility, land use, resilience, equity, and inclusion.

The Austin market ranks strong. According to ULI's 2022 *Emerging Trends in Real Estate*<sup>®</sup>, our community is categorized as a 'Magnet', and we are in a subgroup called 'Supernovas' – considered among those explosive markets that are "on a tear." While we have proven our resilience and are experiencing a resounding resurgence in economic vibrancy, there remain inherent risks that the pandemic has exposed. These seismic shifts have uncovered cracks in our systems and created market alterations that will have ongoing repercussions. We must remain vigilant, adaptable, and proactive.

This year the Urban Land Institute adopted a new mission statement, and ULI Austin has embraced its mission commitments to Connect, Inspire, and Lead. Our District Council Management Committee has identified key priorities for the coming year, and we aspire to measured progress towards our goals. We will not do this alone, so we have adopted a theme that reflects our community at this unique place in time: 'Leadership through Partnership.'

This is an exciting time to be a ULI member, and I am grateful for each of you. I continue to challenge you to get involved, follow your passion, and commit to contributing your time and resources to ensure we remain the kind of resilient community we've proven we can be. Thank you for all you do!
