EDUCATION COMMITTEES

Oversees programs focused on educating individuals ranging from high school, to college, and industry professionals and public officials and staff. ULI needs mentors and presenters for these programs.

HINES STUDENT COMPETITION

Offers graduate students the opportunity to collaborate in multidisciplinary teams and engage in an exercise in responsible land use. December - February

URBANPLAN EXCHANGE

Interactive program for industry professionals, community leaders and policymakers to learn about the fundamental forces that shape and affect the built environment.
