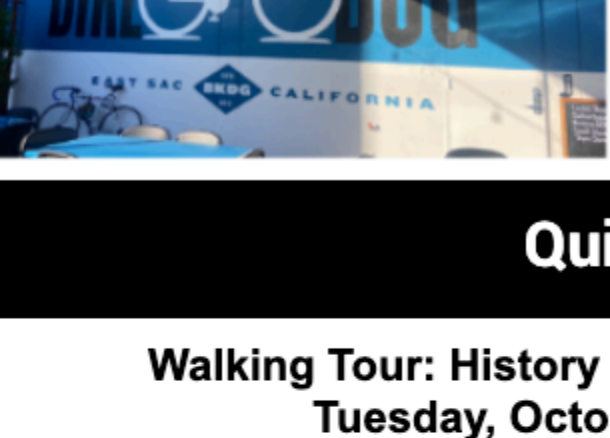

Walking Tour: History of Japantown and Chinatown

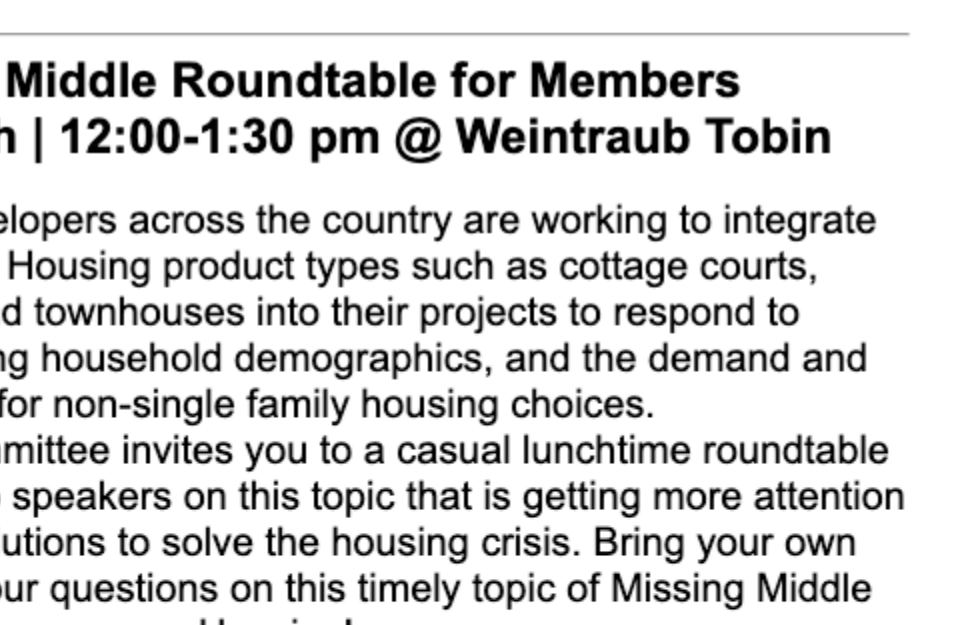
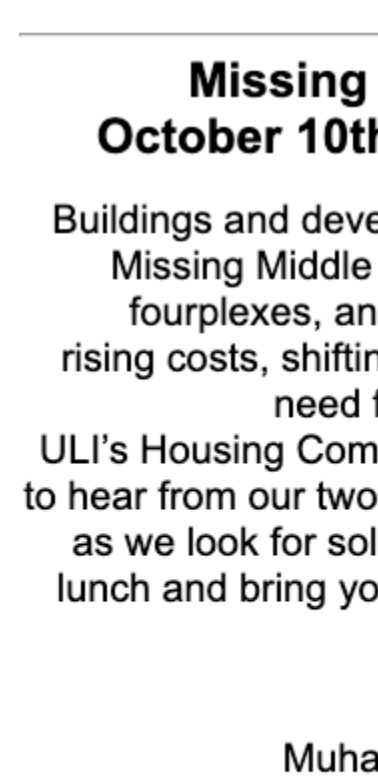
Tuesday, October 1st | 4:00-6:00 pm
